"Living Our Baptism"

OK, Christ died on the cross. Christ is arisen! Alleluia! Now what? God has given Christ to save us from the devil, our sin, all evil, and death. We are promised new life. But what does that life look like?

Let's look at the First Reading for the Day of Pentecost, May 20th this year, "When the day of Pentecost had come, they were all together in one place. And suddenly ... (wind, divided tongues as of fire, praise in different languages ... all heaven breaks out). And everyone was speaking in their own language about God's deeds of power ... All were filled with the Holy Spirit..."

This is the beginning of what new life looks like. Jesus' disciples, all God's people, declare the Good News of the power of God is words and actions. Acts 2 continues, "... everyone who calls on the name of the Lord shall be saved."

Two thousand years after Jesus first came, this is what our life as his disciples looks like. We are empowered by the Holy Spirit to carry out God's saving mission through all the world. We have been baptized into Christ. Now it's time to live our Baptism, strengthened by God's Holy Spirit.

Sometimes we're just not sure how to do that. We are timid about what to say, how to approach people who do not know Jesus. 21st century Christians, especially in the Western world, are really struggling with this. We see evidence of our struggles in the decline of membership and attendance in many congregations, including our own. So, where's the magic bullet that can show us how to be more effective? I don't know where that magic bullet is. But this I do know.

On Sunday, May 20, the day of Pentecost in 2018, we will hear powerful words directed to the church. We will confirm two wonderful young people. And we will declare what our words and actions could be. In the Affirmation of Baptism/Confirmation rite, disciples are called to:

- *Live among God's faithful people;*
- *Hear the word of God and share in the Lords' Supper;*
- *Proclaim the good news of God in Christ through word and deed;*
- *Serve all people, following the example of Jesus;*
- *Strive for justice and peace in all the earth. Amen.*

This is our guide. This is our mission post-Easter. Gracious God, send your Holy Spirit to awaken in your people today these gifts of discipleship.

Our April meeting was the Upper Bucks Women of the ELCA's Spring Gathering. The topic was human trafficking; both sexual and domestic. The speaker, Karen Kutzner, is program director from The Well, an organization that works with local women who have affected by sex trafficking. In her remarks, she talked about where kids were accosted - the mall and social media for example; and the need to educate them as to what to look out for. This is something parents also need to be conscious of. It was a troubling and informative session.
