"Evangelical Lutheran Durham - Stable, Connected -But Called to Risk More for our Lord"

At the Annual Congregational Meeting held on February 24, 2019, we were able to receive a report for the MAPS (Mission Assessment Profile Survey) that fifty or more of you filled out last year. Basically, this is what the survey told us:

- We are a committed congregation.
- We are connected we like each other.
- We are stable because of history (206 years) and generational ties.
- We are financially stable.
- Faith is important to us and not just on Sunday.
- We are willing to give of our money, time, and talents to do the work of the church.
- We trust our congregational leaders and each other.

This is just some of what our survey revealed.

Specifically, in 2018, this is a snapshot of our ministry together. We grew in membership and giving - three new child members and 6 new adults. Two of our youth were confirmed. Two of our children received their First Holy Communion. Our Sunday School enrollment increased to 20 children. Our service and giving to others both near and far continued to increase. We ARE a functioning community of faith, ministering well together.

But, the survey revealed another important challenge for us, and really for all churches in the 21st century. The world, the culture, and religious life has changed drastically, especially in the last 30 or 40 years. Some of you answered survey questions indicating our risk to reach out to the world with God's Good News in new ways. Change is always a challenge for human beings. And it will be a challenge for us. I think we are willing to take the risks to go where God may be calling us **now!!!** 2019 is only the beginning of our new faithfulness. We will be talking about new ways of ministry for the next several years.

Let's get started as we approach this Season of Lent. Ash Wednesday is March 6, with services at 1 PM and 7:30 PM. During the 40 days of Lent, God can renew us through Confession, Worship, and Prayer.
