


**June

There is every hope that the transition process can be at such a point that there might be potential candidates interviewed in the fall. This is great reason for celebration.

We often think that summer is a time for slowing down. I hope you have gotten the idea that that is not what is happening here at Durham. The summer months will be times of gearing up for the fall, and especially for a renewal of the education program. It is also a time when significant decisions will be made regarding the call process and the possibility of calling a fulltime pastor. These decisions will be impacted by decisions regarding the parsonage, the experience level of the pastor desired and what costs may be involved in the full package for the pastor. Regardless of who the new pastor will be, I can assure you that falling behind in the congregational stewardship will not help the cause. The fact is that now is the time to build up the giving in preparation for a new pastor. We can certainly talk about this more in the months ahead, to stay tuned.
