CAPITAL CAMPAIGN



Thanks to the generosity of Dorothea Shaffer and others who have generously donated funds to be able to expand our facilities, we are able to proceed with construction of an annex to the church. This will give our Care-a-Lot Preschool dedicated secure space, offices for the pastor and staff, a multipurpose meeting room, and wheelchair accessible rest room facilities.

The capital campaign is to raise funds to furnish the Annex, and to create a building maintenance fund to ensure that the expanded facility can be maintained and utilized into the future.

Now that we have selected a contractor and have completed groundbreaking, it is time to kick off our Capital campaign. The Campaign will run for three years and It will have two phases:

- Phase 1 - focuses on the "furnishings" needed for the new Annex, and any changes to the existing facilities that are needed to enable moving functions to the Annex.
- Phase 2 - Will have a goals of \$100,000 to replenish the Capital Maintenance fund to provide resources for long-term facilities maintenance.

For Phase 1 Council Liaisons and/or Committee chairs will be reaching out to members of the congregation to help identify the items needed to furnish and supply the new space.

The Capital Campaign and Building committees will use the collected information as input for making a list of items that donors can use to select from that they would like to fund and use as input for purchasing. The list of items and donors will be published in the booklet for the dedication event that will be held when construction is completed.
